NOTICE OF RACE

Organizing Authority: Ngaroto Sailing Club, Bank Road, Te Awamutu

1.0 RULE

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply
- 1.3 For all classes rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty

2.0 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 The Organizing Authority may require all participating boats to display the event sponsor's advertising

3.0 Divisions

- 3.1 Trailer Yacht open division
(There may be some alteration to the above division's dependent on entries)
- 3.2 Any class with six or more boats competing shall be scored as its own division. To qualify entries must be in by 1stth November 2021.
- 3.3 Times for the open divisions will be adjusted by NZTYA handicaps

4.0 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY FEE

- 4.1 All Trailer Yachts
- 4.2 Any boat modification to be declared on entry

- 4.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the official entry form below accompanied by the entry fee and must include any meal bookings by Monday 1st November 2021

The entry fee of \$50.00 may be paid by internet banking or at registration

6.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 6.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration

7.0 RACING AREA

- 7.1 The racing area is Lake Ngारoto

8.0 THE COURSE

- 8.1 The courses will be windward/leeward/triangle or trapezoid

9.0 SCORING

- 9.1 The scoring system will be the low points system
- 9.2 One race will be required to be completed to constitute a series
- 9.3 When fewer than 7 races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of race scores.
- 9.4 When 8 to 10 races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of race scores excluding the worst score
- 9.5 When greater than 10 races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of race scores excluding the two worst scores.

10.0 PRIZES

- 10.1 Prizes will be awarded as for each division

11.0 PRIVACY WAIVER

- 11.1 In participating in the regatta, a competitor grants the organizing authority and the sponsors the right in perpetuity, to make, use and show, from time to time and at their

discretion any motion picture, still picture and live taped or film television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the event

12.0 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

12.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta
